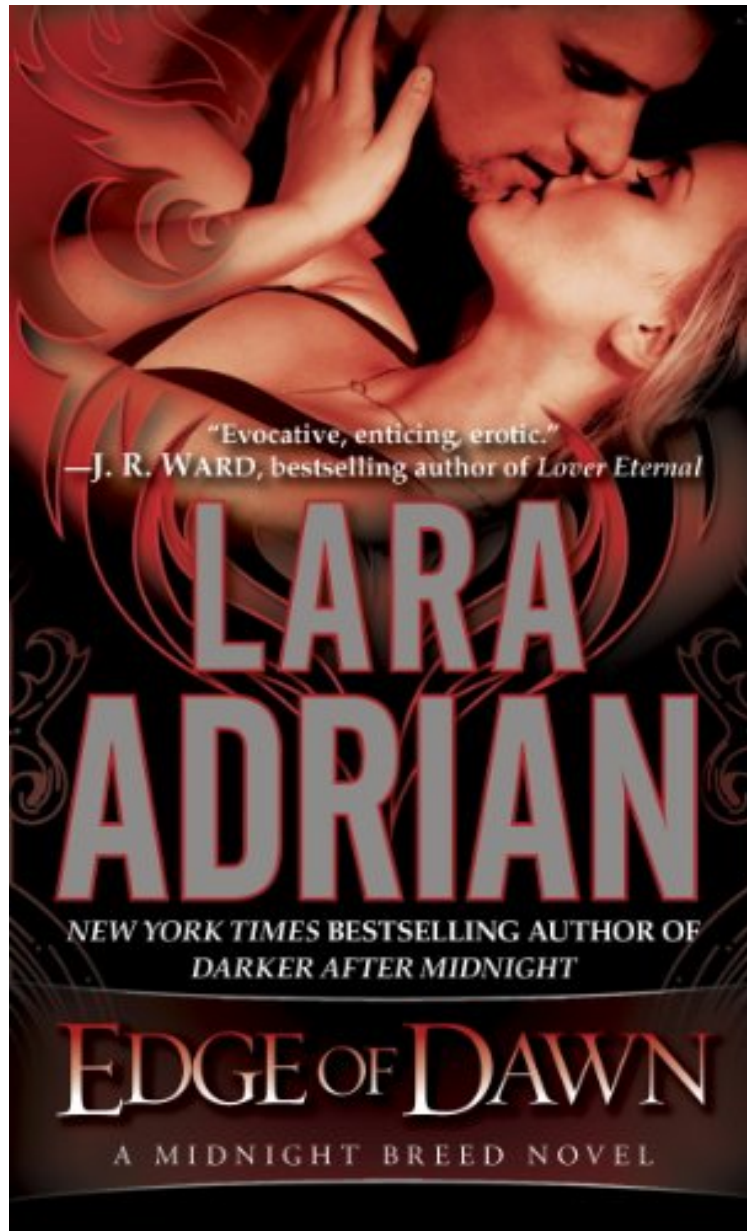

Edge of Dawn is set 20 years after the Breed came out and revealed themselves to the human public. Since then they are working together to ensure peace and to make the world a better place. But there are always forces to rebel against the idea, that humans and "abominations" can cohabitate. We know Mira, the adopted girl of Nikolai and Renata (Veil of Midnight) and Kellan Archer (who was kidnapped by the Rogues and lost almost all of his family) when they were more or less children. Now they are grown-ups...8 years ago Kellan died on a mission with Mira witnessing it. She hasn't stopped mourning all those years and her only purpose in life is revenge against the rebels who took him from her, so she became one of the best female warriors of the order. One day, on a simple bodyguard mission gone wrong, she has an encounter with someone long thought dead. Kellan didn't die but came close. Rescued by a bunch of humans, he became their leader and worked with them hidden from Breed or human eyes. He put the protection of life, human and Breed, before his own needs and even left Mira, his one love. When they come together in a burst of passion, they already know their bleak future (thanks to Miras Breedmate gift), and they try to stop something that may be the end of the fragile peace between the species. In summary I found this book somewhat boring. There is some action at the beginning, when Mira shows how tough she is and at the end when everything blows up, but in between I found myself turning the pages without really reading them. At first Mira is strong in body and mind, but all that crumbles when she meets Kellan again and she forgives him for everything (which I found contradicting even when considering the genre). Kellan thinks all the time about his guilt, but there is never a real reason why he stayed in hiding (he could have contacted Mira and the Order at any time and they would have welcomed him and his group of humans!). So the romance did nothing for me, there were no real obstacles which could have added to the thrill. The overall story was even more boring, all this "the old warriors and their mates coming together" just hindered the development of this new beginning, with new characters. It was just too much. 3 stars because I like the series and Lara Adrians extraterrestrial vampire offspring but I was honestly a bit disappointed.

Von javelinx20 Jahre sind vergangen, seit sich die Breed unter der Fhrung von Lucan den Menschen offenbart haben; eine Zeitenwende, die als "First Dawn" in die Geschichte eingegangen ist und von zahllosen Kmpfen und Opfern gefolgt wurde. Nun soll ein Gipfeltreffen aller Nationen und der Breed friedlichere Zeiten bringen, und der Orden steht mit den Sicherheitsvorkehrungen in hchster Alarmbereitschaft. Mira, die als einziges Breedmate zur Anfhlerin eines Sicherheitsteams aufgestiegen ist, erhlt den Auftrag, einen Wissenschaftler zum Gipfel zu eskortieren. Schnell wird klar, dass dies kein einfacher Auftrag wird... Mit EDGE OF DAWN lutet Lara Adrian eine neue Epoche fr die Vampire ein, die nicht mehr wie bisher von Heimlichkeiten gegenber den ahnungslosen Menschen geprgt ist, sondern eine mehr dystopische Atmosphre schafft, in denen die Vampire um eine neue Rolle kmpfen und sich gegen Intrigen, Hinterhalte und blutige Auseinandersetzungen stemmen mssen. Mit dem Zeitsprung von 20 Jahren kann sie Mira nun als erwachsene Kmpferin ins Rampenlicht rcken und die Geschichte von ihr und Kellan nach ihrer Jugendfreundschaft weitererzhlen. Mit Mira gibt es eine Vielzahl weiterer neuer Charaktere, vor allem sind mehrere Kinder der Paare aus bisherigen Folgen, die damals noch nicht einmal Nachwuchs geplant hatten, mit von der Partie. Damit hat die Autorin den Boden bereitet fr eine zweite Staffel der Serie, in der es viele interessante Figuren gibt, zuztlich gibt es viele spannende Anstze durch das nicht immer ungetrkte Verhltnis der neuen Generation mit ihren Eltern, z.B. tut sich Lucan sehr schwer, zu akzeptieren, dass sein Sohn zum Krieger herangewachsen ist und in den Kampf ziehen mchte; auch der Sohn von Dante verfgt ber auergewhnliche Fhigkeiten. So viel Material damit als Grundstein fr knftige Fortsetzungen gelegt wird, bremst es gleichzeitig die Spannung dieser ersten "neuen" Folge und lsst sie berfrachtet und streckenweise schleppend wirken. Hatte man sich in bisherigen Folgen immer ber ein Wiedersehen mit liebgewonnenen Charakteren freuen knnen, gert es nun mehr zur Pflichtveranstaltung, bis alle namentlich erwht sind und ihr neuer Wirkungsbereich genannt ist; viel Neues erfhrt man trotzdem nicht. Auf der anderen Seite bekommt der Leser nur drftige Informationen ber die neue Generation, was zwar das Interesse weckt, aber nicht gengend die Neugier befriedigt, um den roten Faden der Handlung weiterzutragen. Darberhinaus verlft auch die Romanze zwischen Mira und Kellan schleppend; nachdem es nur wenig einsehbar wirkt, wieso sich Kellan all die Jahre zurckgezogen und damit auch die Treue als Krieger des Ordens verletzt hat, entsteht nur wenig Prickeln, und die Kmpfe laufen auf ein ebenso vorhersehbares wie unglckliches Ende zu. Erst am Schluss ist wieder mehr von der Dramatik und dem Gefhl der bisherigen Serie wiederzuerkennen. Nachdem Dragos ausgeschaltet ist, wird nun ein Gruppe neuer Feinde eingefhrt, die dem Orden noch viel Kopfzerbrechen bereiten drfte und der neuen Kriegergeneration reichlich Gelgenheit, sich zu bewhren. Nachdem die bisherige Serie so viele vertraute Charaktere hervorgebracht hat, kann man es der Autorin zumindest zutrauen, auf der Basis dieses bergangsbuches in weiteren Folgen die einzelnen neuen Figuren herauszuarbeiten; ich wrde sehr gerne mehr ber die Shne und Tchter der verschiedenen Krieger und die anderen Mitglieder der Teams wie Nathan und Torin erfahren und werde auf jeden Fall an der Serie dranbleiben.
