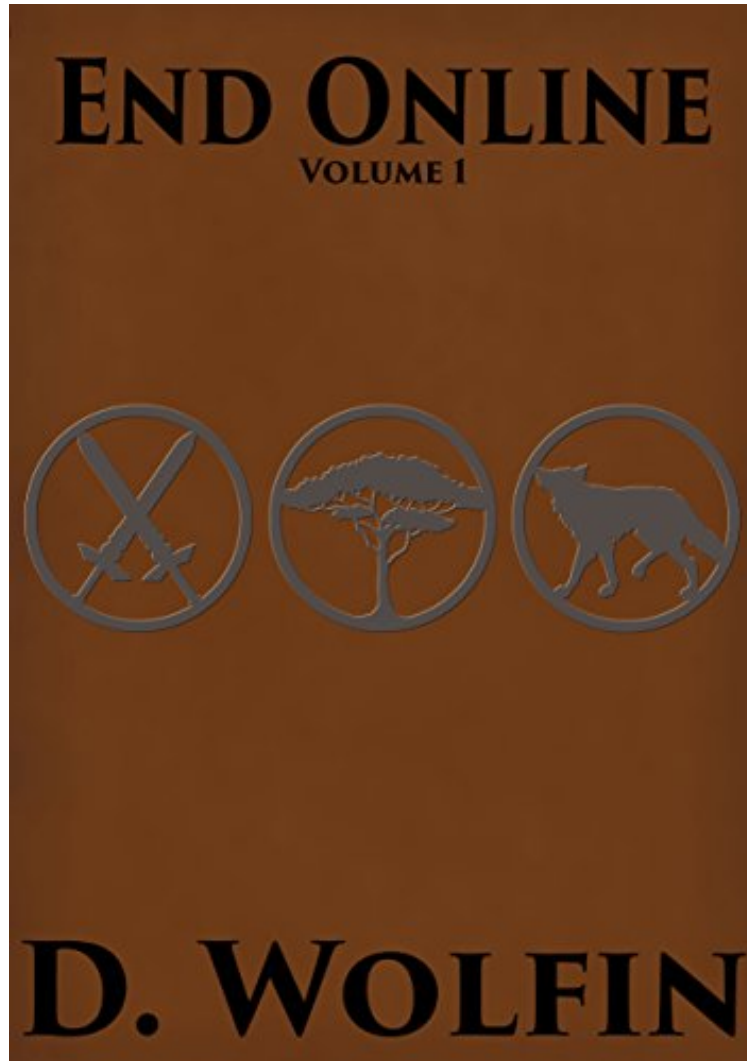

Decent StoryVon RionI have read End Online Volume I-IV and overall enjoyed the books.For the first part, and in some aspects including the other books as well, the initial story of how the protagonist starts with diving into the virtual reality game seems very strange, illogical and makes no real sense whatsoever.Accidents happen and using an accident as an excuse to get into a VR game makes a lot of sense. However the circumstances around this incident, with his family, his job and the general situation are a bit too drastic. It felt to me as if the author had no idea of legal matters and just wanted a quick and easy excuse to get family and other problems like work out of the way quickly and did not

give it enough thought. I would have preferred it, if the protagonist simply had no family in the first place, because using them as a reason / motivation in the later books is very strange when he just "dropped" all his family ties in the first place without any legal struggle whatsoever. Once these family topics are out of the way though, the actual story starting with the setting of the in-game world gets really nice and well thought out. The inter-character relationship between the protagonist and his companion as well as the other players he meets is well written, the characters have depth and some character development can be seen throughout the story arc. The world gets bigger and more detailed little bit by bit and there is enough interesting action going on to keep it fun and entertaining. Overall a nice book, if a little bit on the short side. My rating is somewhere in the 3-4 star range, if you enjoy virtual reality and fantasy books then I'd definitely give it a read.
