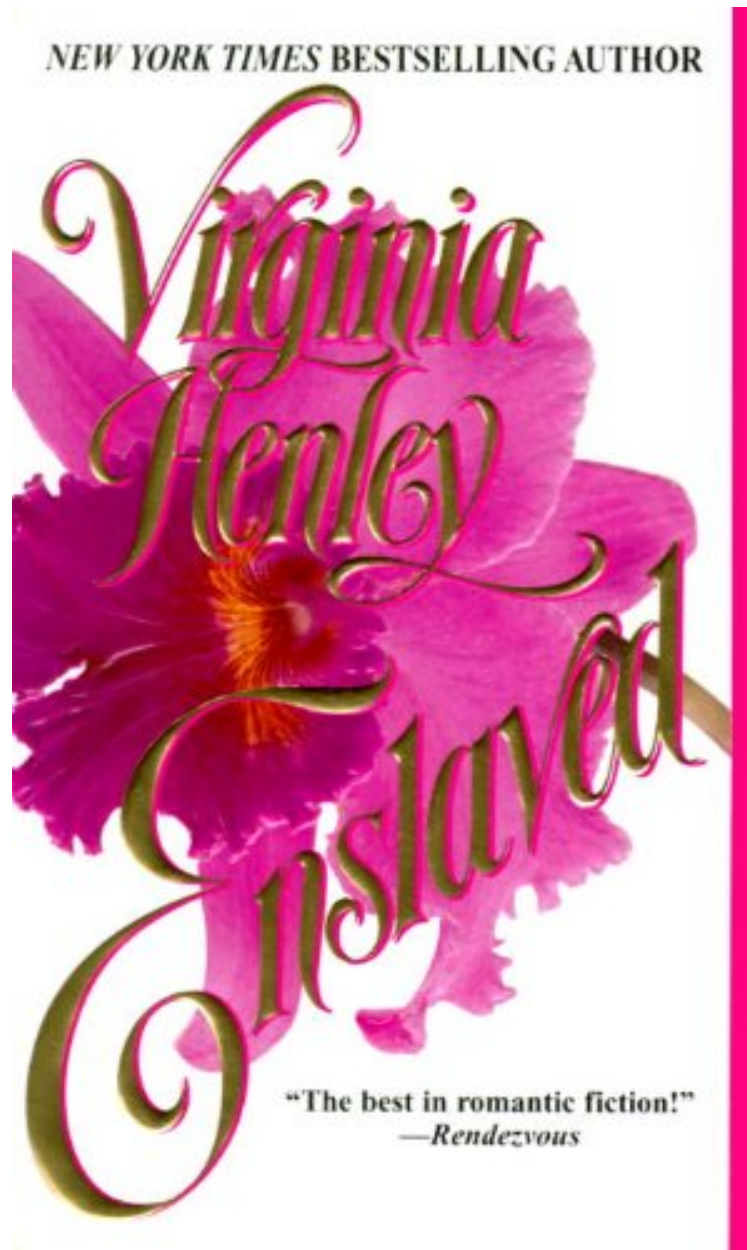

For example, Diana, the heroine, is described as intellectual, yet the main focus of the book is sex.
