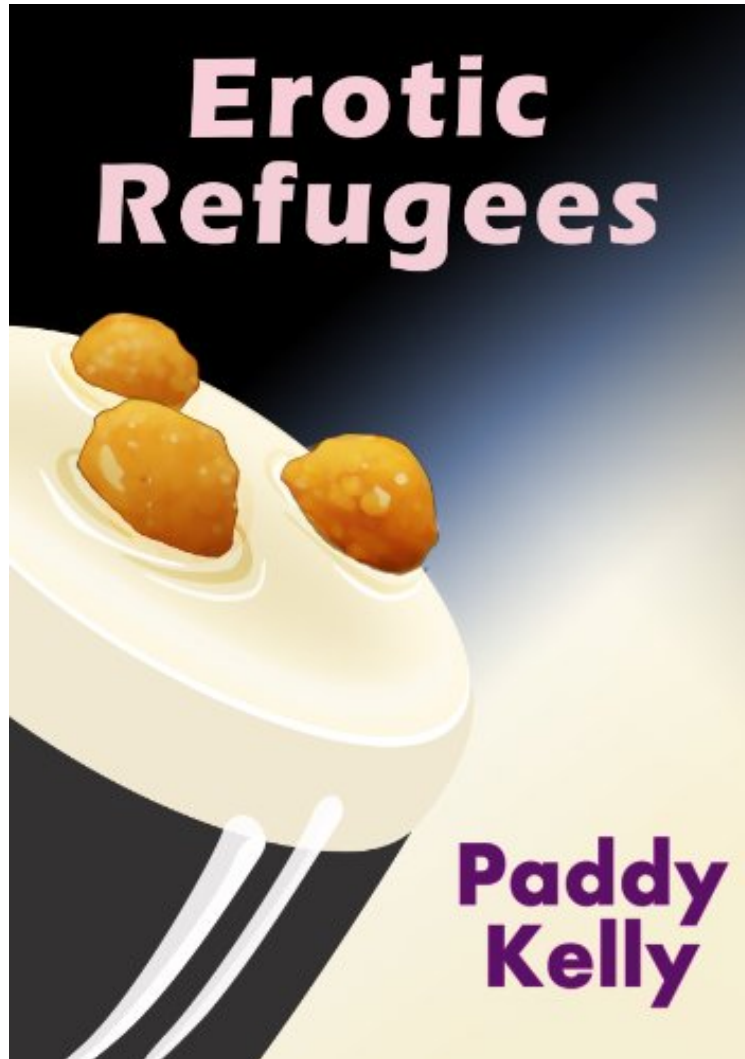

The story gets going when the two set up a site of their own, with the able assistance of Millie who Rob meets through his unemployment agency and Rob 's teenage sister. While their website

doesn't fly, other ideas do and some people. find love while others find themselves. Erotic Refugees is delightful and witty and I romped through it in a day. Readers who enjoy chick lit or lad lit would find it a rewarding read, despite the fact that it is entirely without the shoe and brand references of the former and the implicit misogyny of the latter. If you are prepared to gird your loins and go beyond the cover, which in no way represents the intelligent writing within, then you will be amply rewarded.
