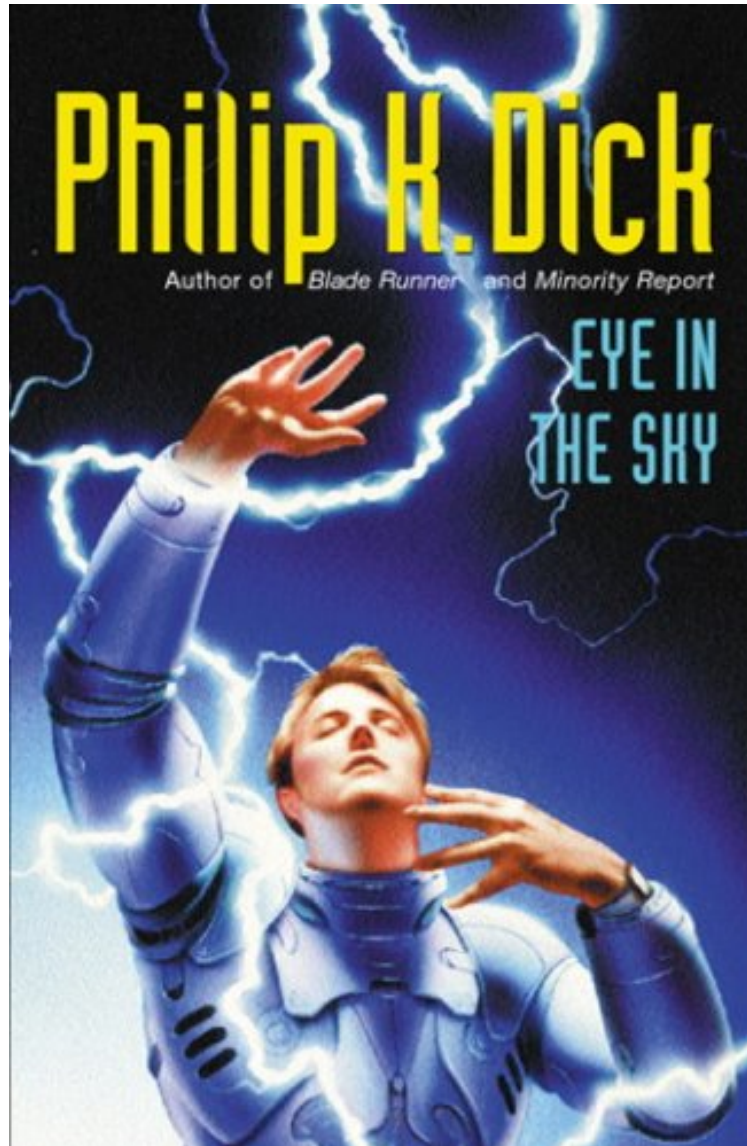

It was both entertaining and easy to read and it had a real ending(!) - which on the other hand makes it less classic than my favourite 'Palmer Eldritch' or 'Ubik'.
