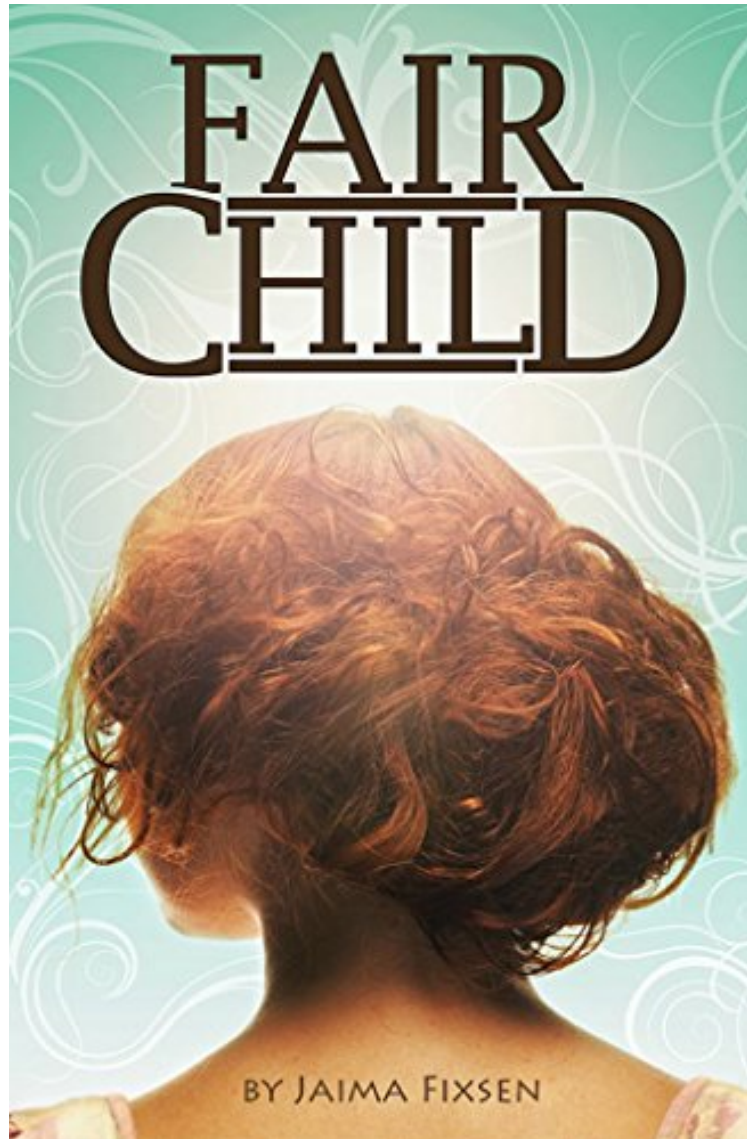

Several aspects of the plot provide interesting points that rouse your curiosity and make you read closely in order not to miss anything instead of speeding through the book as I have through many of the shallower regency novels. For instance, the circumstances of the girl's mother's death dare to make you laugh in their absurdity, were it not so sad for the little child. I was also pleasantly surprised by the absence of stepmother or stepsibling clichs.
