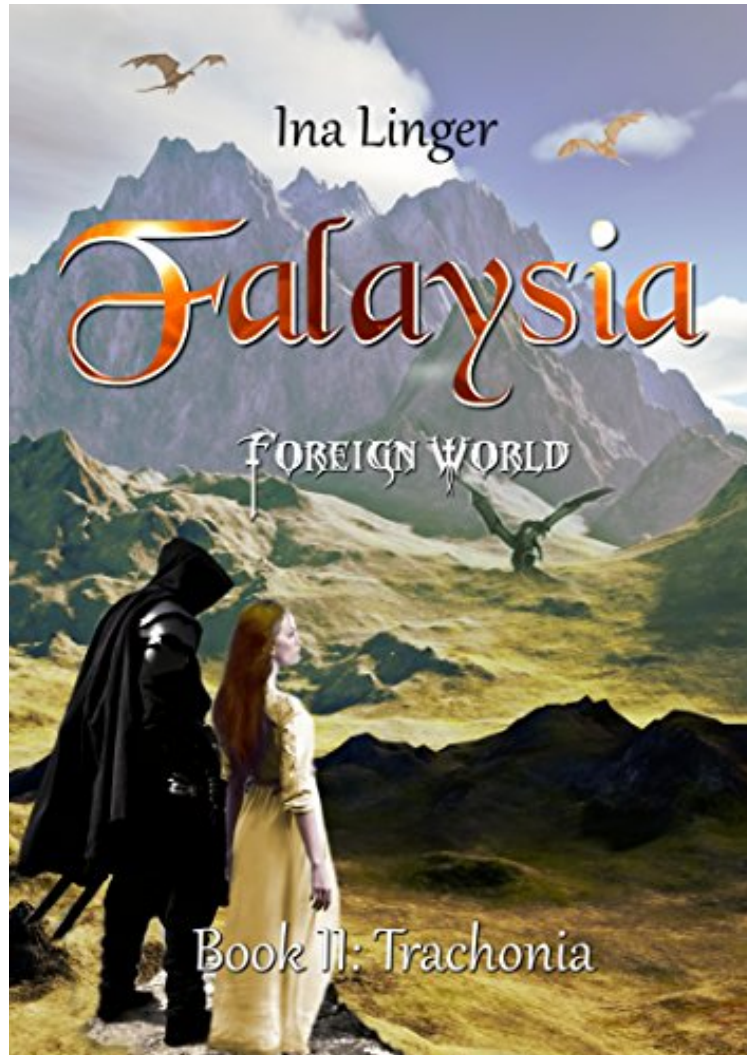

and the wastelands, the Trachjen call their home. But soon Jenna discovers that danger is not only lurking from the outside in the form of the small dragons and their giant, far more imposing cousins, or strange warrior tribes like the Quavi. Thus, the young, average heroine is confronted with new challenges, that bring her to her physical and mental limits. Review : In Volume Two, which connects seamlessly to the cliffhanger of its predecessor, everything continues to revolve around the three main characters Jenna, Leon and Marek. While Jenna and Leon are working towards a common goal, Marek's motives are not yet revealed completely. The development of the characters continues with as much attention to detail as they started in Volume 1 (Allgrizia). So, we as the readers can observe under the spell of the story, how Jenna goes through a slow but steady adaptation to her destiny, without ever entirely giving into it. In her desperate search for a way home, she is forced to accept new ways of thinking and even the fantastic and has to learn to deal with it. These circumstances often force her to her knees, but can also make her grow personally. Even the charismatic and enigmatic Marek shows many facets of his personality. From joyous narrative guide, protector and friend up to the dreaded dragon tyrant and war master, we see him mainly through Jenna's perspective. With him, the author once again demonstrates her great skill in creating interesting, compelling and complex characters. The character of Leon goes through the least developments in this story in my opinion, but his journey to the Kingdom Trachonia also manages to captivate the reader and makes them suffer alongside the injured protagonists that is partially fighting for his life and lets us experience the ups and downs of this journey. In the main part of the book we this time learn much more about the country that is Falaysia, its people and its history. The author succeeds again to bring this alien world to the reader in a very detailed and vivid way. The actual storyline of (to return Jenna to her world) is consciously pushed into the background. However, these "background informations" are valuable and very compelling and important to understand the country and people living in it and offer especially for Marek the necessary background knowledge to understand the man he has become and that the legends and horror stories want to make him be. But the real action is well advanced, so that the verbosity some miniseries fall victim to stays absent. The level of action in Falaysia is framed by the parallel action in the "real world" in which Melina and Jenna's brother Benjamin join forces to try to help Jenna and cross the plans of shady Demeon. Again, the author adds a few surprising twists and information concerning both narrative levels and therefore influences the course of the story and her characters development. She is cleverly allowing glimpses at the extent of what the reader is still kept in the dark about with each piece of the puzzle that is revealed. Overall, I think 'Falaysia Volume 2 - Trachonia' is a very worthy and compelling successor to the first big , and now also award-winning , best-selling novel of the young author. The story is captivating and the course very fluid and easy to follow . The characters, complemented by the vivid narrative style, also are the strongest factor of the books and feature a depth that is often missed in a lot of fictional characters created on a series of several volumes. Volume 3 is already in the works and I am already looking forward to a reunion with this fantastic world and its inhabitants.
