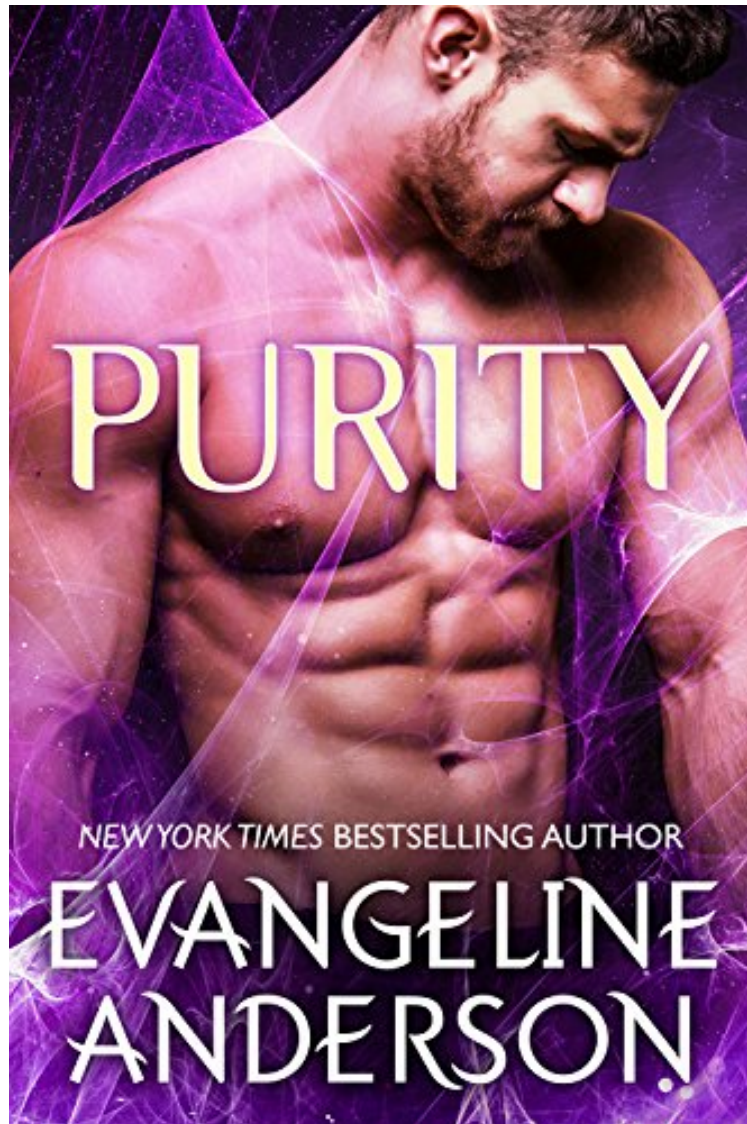

Anderson's Brides of the Kindred series for ages. Actually, I've been following the series since the second volume came out. I'm a huge fan of EA's very interesting take on sci-fi (not so many boring, and page-long explanations about how the awesome engine in the awesome ship actually works, which I find extremely tedious to read - instead, EA always gives the reader details: cool animals, cool cultures, and so many other small things. I'm a huge fan of her for exactly that reason. Every time I think there's nothing she new she could possibly come up with, she dishes out something completely amazing and interesting!) and her knack for romance that doesn't bore me to death. Purity had an amazing concept: the Purists, some kind of group of fanatic people who believe that purging emotions will make them part of their deity, "Purity", and who want to purge the whole universe of dirty things like sex and the people who take part in sexual acts. Touching is forbidden for Purists. Born from tanks instead of wombs, they are clones in skinsuits that they can never take off for any reason. The skinsuit protects, nourishes and controls the Purists. Their biggest fear is contamination, or the touch of another being. K, a fourth level Paladin (that's a high level in the Purist Army), wakes up with her skinsuit gone and her body contaminated - with no way to know what happened to her. She meets Boone, a medical doctor from Colossus, who needs K to save his sister... I found the basic concept of "Purity" extremely interesting. The idea of the Purist Army, mindlessly purging the Universe of the "barbarians" was really cool and held a lot of potential. Mostly, Purity fulfilled that potential. But I feel that the book lacked in a few places. I was a bit disappointed in the lack of world-building. Considering that Purity was supposed to be a stand-alone novel at first, too little information was given to the reader. We never find out what Purity is and what the hell is going on behind closed doors. Who orchestrates Purity? How did it begin? And what are the intergalactical relations? At first, it seemed like the Purists were feared everywhere, as if they were controlling the whole Universe. But later, it turns out that's not true. There is very little information given on the background, and I'm slightly disappointed about that. I hope that, since Purity is now at least a two-book series, we will find more about the background. The second thing that bothered me was that K dominated the book completely. Boone was more of a side character, and he wasn't even that important. Actually, the book would probably have been better and more interesting without him, and with the entire focus on K, who was a really fleshed-out character. In contrast to her, Boone was incredibly colorless and pretty boring, too. We never find out what his history is, or what his motivations and dreams are. All he wants is to save his sister and later, to make K happy. That didn't satisfy me at all. I believe that relationships have to be equal, and Boone was just K's unnecessary side-kick. That's pretty sad. All in all, I believe that Purity was a good novel that could have been great. 3,7 stars rounded up to 4. I'm looking forward to read the sequel!
