This book, I couldn't get out of, painful as it was to read at times. Boy, what a ride! My cuticles can sympathize with Brad's 'cause they're all but gone as well by now.Basically,

this is about three friends, the "Three Musky Queers" as they call themselves--Duff (my only point of critique with this book--what kind of name is DUFF??), Garrett and Jackson, who all dream of finding love, the one true love, and go about it/ stumble across it/get beaten over the head with it in different ways. And then there are the secondary characters--Moonshine (although I hesitate to call her a secondary character and she'd surely have my hide for that too, the way she almost steals away the show from the guys), Brad, Jennica, Landon, Eli, Adam, and Scott, each a person in their own right, each with hopes, dreams and sometimes, an agenda of their own. The book started out with two almost separate storylines, following two of the intended couples, by and by bringing them together to a heart-racing finale. Even though I hated reading on at times, I just had to find out what happened next (see above, my poor cuticles...) and I can only sit back and stare in awe at what the author did to the story, to the characters and to me, the reader. Reading this book felt like listening to a symphonic piece of music, perhaps "The Moldau" by Smetana--leading melody and counterpoint parallel, gradually running together, broken up by an entertaining, lighter interlude, then once again linking together and weaving into one another, building up tension, building and building toward a glorious, exploding-rainbow, thundering climax and then calming down, petering out to a quiet, heartwarming coda. It wasn't as if this book didn't have its flaws, starting with a number of clichés and not ending with a rabbit-out-of-the-magic-hat solution to most everybody's problems. But you know what? I didn't care a bit, that's how wrapped up and sucked into the story I became. Not lastly thanks to the fast-paced, smooth writing that had me reading just one more sentence, just one more paragraph when I really should've been doing other things. Masterfully done, and topped off with not one, but three-and-a-half HEA's, with everyone getting what they deserve for once and decorated with one of the very best female characters I've come across in a while.
