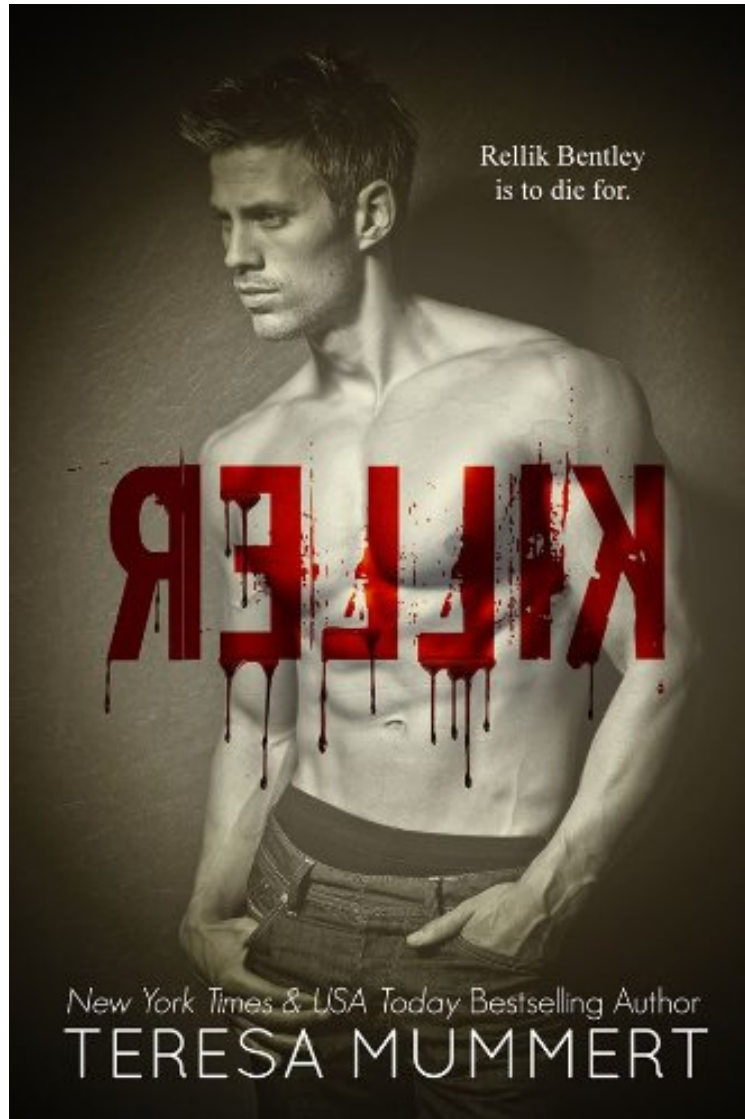

I expected a typical dark romance but nothing about Rellik is typical. This book is extraordinary in every way the plot, the characters as well as the writing style.This book captivated me, lured me in

and didn't let me go. I lost sleep over it and was late for work because I couldn't stop reading. I don't even know where to start. From reading the blurb, I expected Rellik to be the world's biggest jerk with psychopathic tendencies. Instead, I was introduced to a hot-as-sin rockstar that though consumed by darkness, is still more human than he gives himself credit for. Fate has treated him as her own personal punching bag, leaving him broken and void of any happiness or joy. Trying to get through life without being haunted by his memories, he chooses to live an empty life with women, booze and no attachments. This changes when Ella enters his life. Feeling an inexplicable connection, he can't help but allow her to get under his skin not realizing that they have more in common than he could ever imagine. Instead of her frowning upon his thirst for revenge, he finds support from her that he would have never expected. As easy as it would be to hate the person that is Rellik and the things he does, he makes it hard to see things in black and white. He managed to bring my views of right and wrong out of balance. He totally got under my skin. The versatility of his character allows him for a lot of depth, making it hard to judge him. He isn't just a man who was broken and who now enjoys to break others. There is a sweet and caring side to him. He's a person that is able to give love and be vulnerable once he allows himself to be. But there is always an edge and a darkness to his softer side that makes him intense, fascinating, sexy and enthralling. A perfectly written book boyfriend. Ella isn't behind on those qualities in the least. It absolutely thrilled me to see both characters having that type of draw, strength and interesting personalities. None of them was stronger or weaker than the other. Another thing she has in common with Rellik, is that fate hasn't been kind to her either. But instead of being broken by the horrific experiences in her life, it made her strong, determined and vengeful to the ones that deserve it. No longer allowing herself to be a victim, she fights for herself and stands her ground not willing to back down until she finds the answers she is searching for and until the ones that wronged her get what they deserve. Being strong doesn't mean the demons of her past don't haunt her, forcing her to find ways to cope and not allowing her to open up to anyone or to give her trust. This changes when Rellik enters her life. The darkness he exudes simultaneously draws her in and pushes her away. But the pull she feels towards him is so strong that she cannot ignore it. Stronger than the fear of trusting him or revealing her true self. The connection between them is like gasoline to a fire, it is so intense that it made my skin crackle. They both accept each other's broken parts without hesitation or second thoughts, also accepting the darkness that each of them carries. Nothing they do or experience is dull or predictable the intensity of their personalities mirrored in their actions. For me as a reader there wasn't a moment to catch my breath, yet it wasn't too much or over the top. And everytime when I thought I figured everything out, the story revealed another truth that I hadn't expected or seen coming. There were no hints to give things away which made the shock even bigger. And I absolutely loved it. The writing style is unique and extraordinarily superb. It is intelligent and eloquent, original and beautiful full of emotion, intensity and breath-taking metaphors. And what makes it even better is the fact that not only the main characters and their story are intriguing, but that the supporting characters Phantom, Hangman and Trigger have managed to worm their way into my heart as well. I am secretly or not so secretly hoping that maybe they get their own story too. That'd be like Christmas and Easter all at once. Mummert's style of writing and her ability to set a tone and atmosphere that make it impossible to not feel the story takes you to a whole new world in her bad-ass novel "Rellik". A world full of heartache, pain and broken characters that will have two people find love in the most unexpected of instances. And just when you think you know what's going on, Mummert does what she does best she throws a plot twist at you so hard, it'll knock your reading glasses off your nose. She is my absolute favorite when it comes to those, to plot twists... if there was a plot twist kingdom, Teresa Mummert would be its Queen, its Goddess. I really liked the characters - especially the band members, and I wish there was a book about each one of them and their individual... history. I also absolutely loved the story itself, even if it was a bit too fast-paced at times, especially when it came to the development of what was going on between Rellik and Ella. The use of lyrics and the definitions in the beginning of each chapter were also very enjoyable, and it was great learning about Rellik's past by getting a glance at it via flashbacks. Overall, judging only the story and general way of storytelling, I am dying to give this novel a five star rating. The editing, however, made me cringe far too many times - had this been an unedited pre-publication edition, an ARC, I would be jumping at the opportunity of throwing my 'five' at it, assuming that all errors would be corrected by the time of release... but seeing this was a purchased published paperback, I can't just go and ignore all the misspelling, missing apostrophes and other errors that I got caught on without even being on the lookout. I am not going to lie - the editing, or at times rather the lack thereof, made this an occasionally utterly frustrating read, and the love-hate-relationship I've had with the book made me debate between a three and a four star rating. In the end, I will be settling for four - because my love for Rellik and the story told in the novel are winning over my frustration with the editing - without which, this would have definitely been a five star read!
