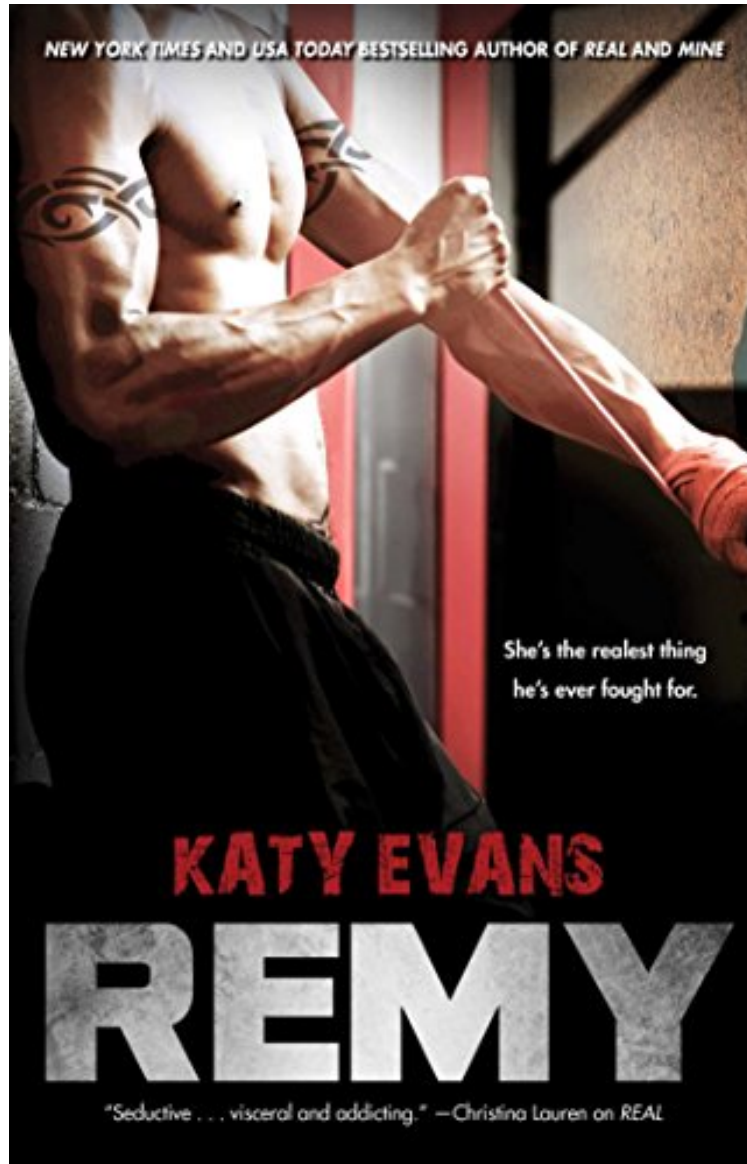

In Real and Mine we were emerged in Brookes thoughts and emotions, only getting glimpses of what Remy thought or felt. Now we get a chance to experience it all from his point of view, to learn his thoughts, his feelings. And damn, there is a lot still to learn about this man. Though the book replays some of the scenes from the other books, having Remys point of view makes them different, more intense. While before we could only guess what is going on inside of him, now we get to find out. We do not need to make assumptions. Instead we get a look into his head and his heart. And it is not just repetition of the other books. There are so many added scenes moments when Remy wasnt with Brooke. Learning about his feelings for Brooke I couldnt help but swoon. Some might call it obsession, I call it true love. He worships the ground she is walking on. There is nothing he wouldnt do to make her his, to prove himself worthy of her, to show her his love. While he knows he wants her from the first moment he laid eyes on her, he is wary of his mental illness and of hurting her. The inner struggle between allowing her to love him and protecting her from himself is torturing not just to him but to me as the reader as well. There is not a second he is not aware of the darkness that looms over him due to his illness. Constantly battling against the symptoms of being bipolar, trying his hardest not to let them win and yet knowing he will fail again and again, his life is a constant challenge. It was written so well by Katy Evans that all I wanted to do is to find a way to take away Remys pain. To make him realize how beautiful he is inside and out. And it takes a lot of patience and determination from Brooke for him to start and realize this. And even then he still doubts how it is possible for him to be loved by someone. It was interesting to see Brooke through his eyes. Before we only got her view of situations and of herself. Now we are allowed to see situations differently as well as learn more about Brooke. I loved that about this book. It made her character even more real. Another great thing about reading Remys POV was that I got information on the things I wondered about before, like Remys confrontation with Scorpion, him deciding to hire Brooke and so many more. This book also allows us to get to know Riley and Pete better and I like them even more. The way they interact with Remy, the way they deal with his mood swings and his illness and the way they loyally stand by his side no matter what made me smile throughout the book.
