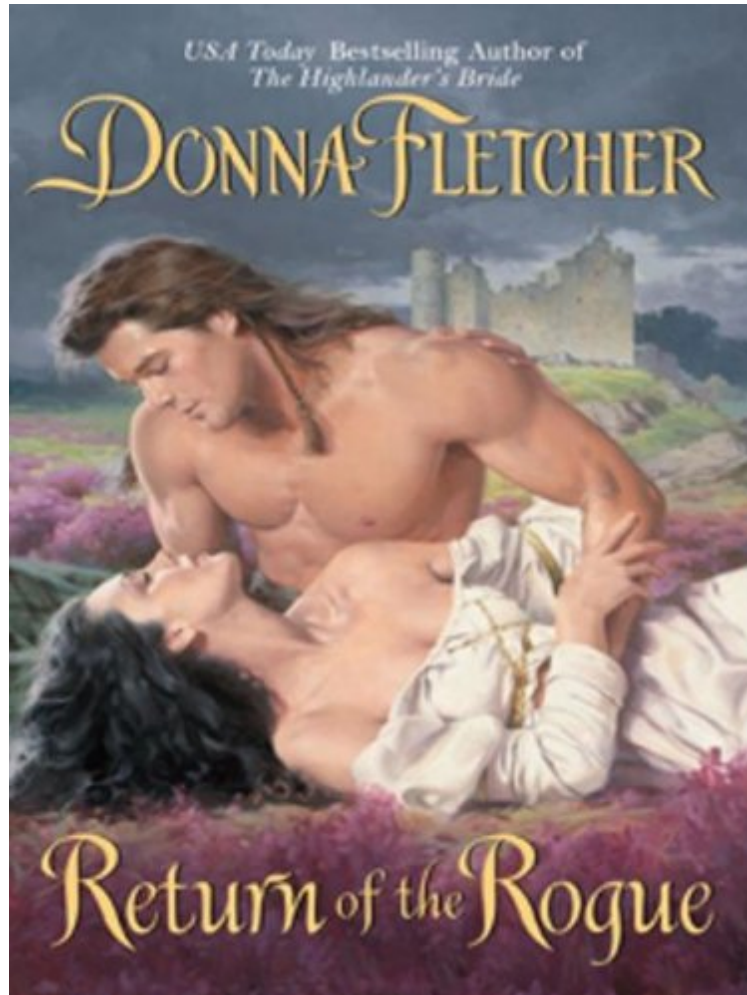

Doch rechtzeitig zur Hochzeit taucht Artairs Bruder Cavan auf, der nach einer Schlacht in die Gefangenschaft verschleppt wurde, und erst jetzt nach Hause zurckkehrte. Da der Ehevertrag auf eine Hochzeit mit dem Erben des Sinclare-Clans lautet, und Cavan der ltere Bruder ist, sieht Honora sich pltzlich mit Cavan statt mit Artair vermhlt. Cavan, der sie schon als Kind einschcherte, und aus dem die Gefangenschaft einen aufbrausenden unzugnglichen Einzelngner machte. Auch Cavan ist von seiner Vermhlung nicht

begeistert. In Honora sieht er eine graue Maus, die keine der Eigenschaften verfügt, die er sich in einer Ehefrau wünscht. Zudem ist der jüngste der Sinclair-Brüder noch immer verschollen, und Cavan, der sich dafür verantwortlich fühlt, will alle Energie darauf konzentrieren, Ronan zu finden, koste es, was es wolle. "Return Of The Rogue" spielt im 16. Jahrhundert, es könnte aber auch das achte oder dreizehnte sein, da die Autorin sich mit historischen Details sehr zurückhält. Das einzige, was man erfährt, ist, dass "Barbaren" die schottischen Dörfer befallen und eben diese sind Cavan und sein Bruder in die Hände gefallen. Der Mangel an Details tut dieser Geschichte jedoch keinen Abbruch, Cavan und Honora sind überzeugend, ihre Beziehung entwickelt sich glaubhaft, wenn man auch manchmal das Gefühl hat, ein Kapitel zu lesen zu haben, da die Geschichte an Stellen Zeitsprünge macht, die etwas überraschen. Möglicherweise ist dies ein Stilmittel der Autorin, von der ich bisher nichts weiter gelesen habe. Auch die Nebencharaktere sind interessant und man würde sich wünschen, dass auch Cavans Bruder eigene Bücher bekommen, in der Form, wie dies zum Beispiel Kinley MacGregor mit den MacAllisters macht. Von Helen Hancox Honora Tannach's life is very difficult; her mother has died and her stepfather Calum treats her cruelly, regularly beating her. Honora's mouse-like nature has been noticed by others, most notably the oddly-named Cavan Sinclair, the man her father wants her to marry. Unfortunately for Calum, Cavan was unwilling to marry someone who wasn't strong and courageous. However, several years later it appears that Calum is getting his wish - Cavan has gone missing and his next brother, Artair, has agreed to marry Honora. But after the wedding ceremony is completed Honora's life turns upside down again when Cavan reappears and her father proves that Honora was married to the Laird's Heir, not to Artair in particular, and she is now Cavan's wife. Cavan doesn't want a wife, particularly not a quiet mousy woman like Honora, and especially as his whole focus is on trying to discover whereabouts of his brother Ronan who was captured by barbarians at the same time as Cavan. But as Cavan and Honora spend time together and as she escapes her stepfather's influence they both discover that Honora is rather different than she first appeared. Can Honora help Cavan to overcome his feelings of responsibility in Ronan's situation? Can Cavan vocalise his feelings of love? Is the evil person working for the barbarians going to be unmasked? This was rather a lightweight story with the central section rather losing its way and the instigator of the plot against Cavan's family obvious from the first. The historical detail was interesting in places although the dialogue occasionally slipped into American rather than Scottish. Characterisation also felt a little weak with people's feelings explained rather than described. It wasn't a bad book, just felt rather light on plot and characterisation and many of the characters that peopled the pages did feel rather stereotypical of this kind of book.
