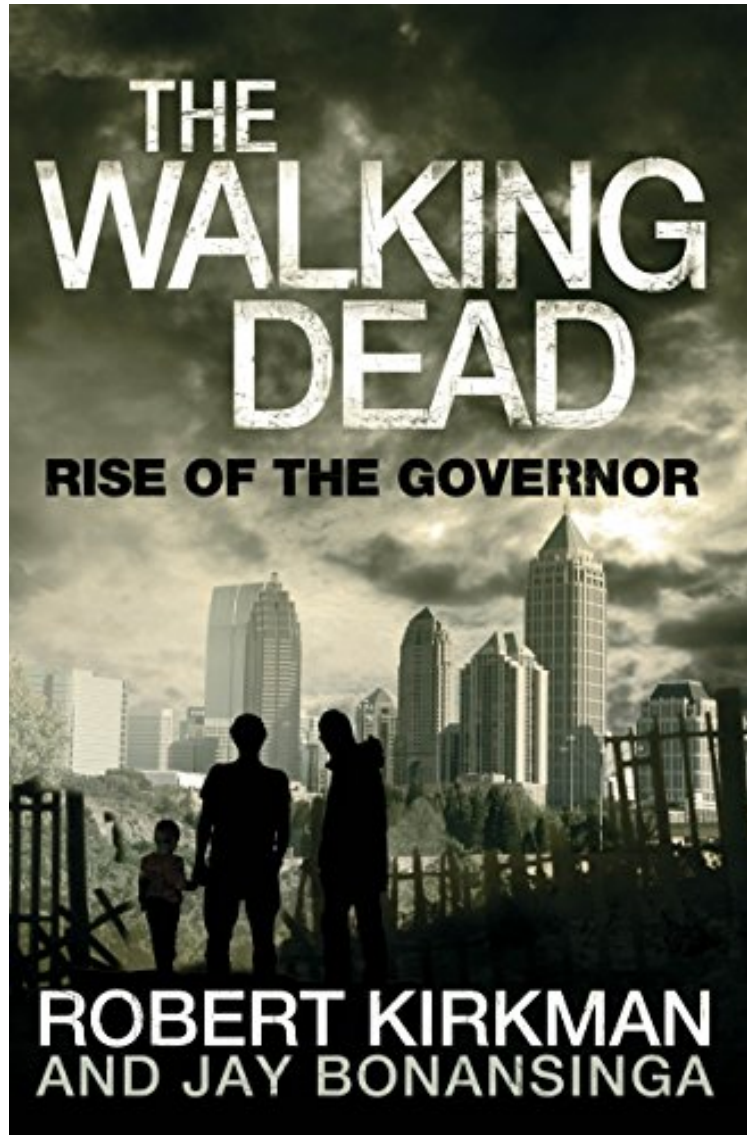

The story writing is very well done, keeps you caught in and very imaginative about the things that happen. The first half is fairly slow and calm, it of course doesn't get boring, it is written in a way to bring you closer to the characters.
