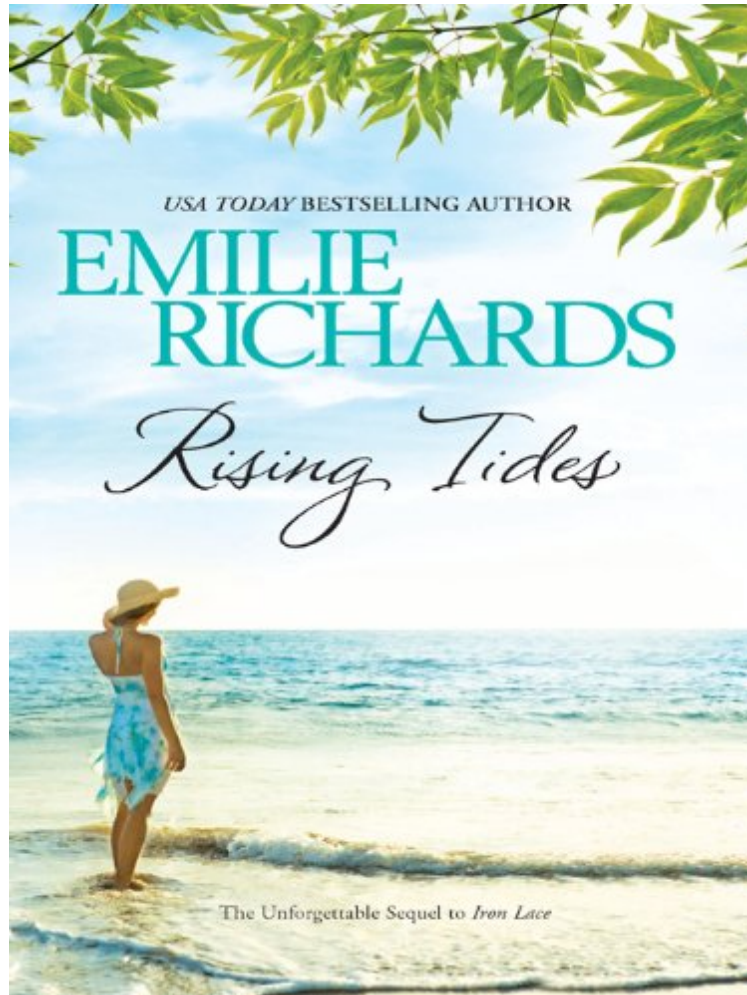

Only after I'd finished *Sea Swept* did I discover that Nora Roberts is a romantic fiction writer.
