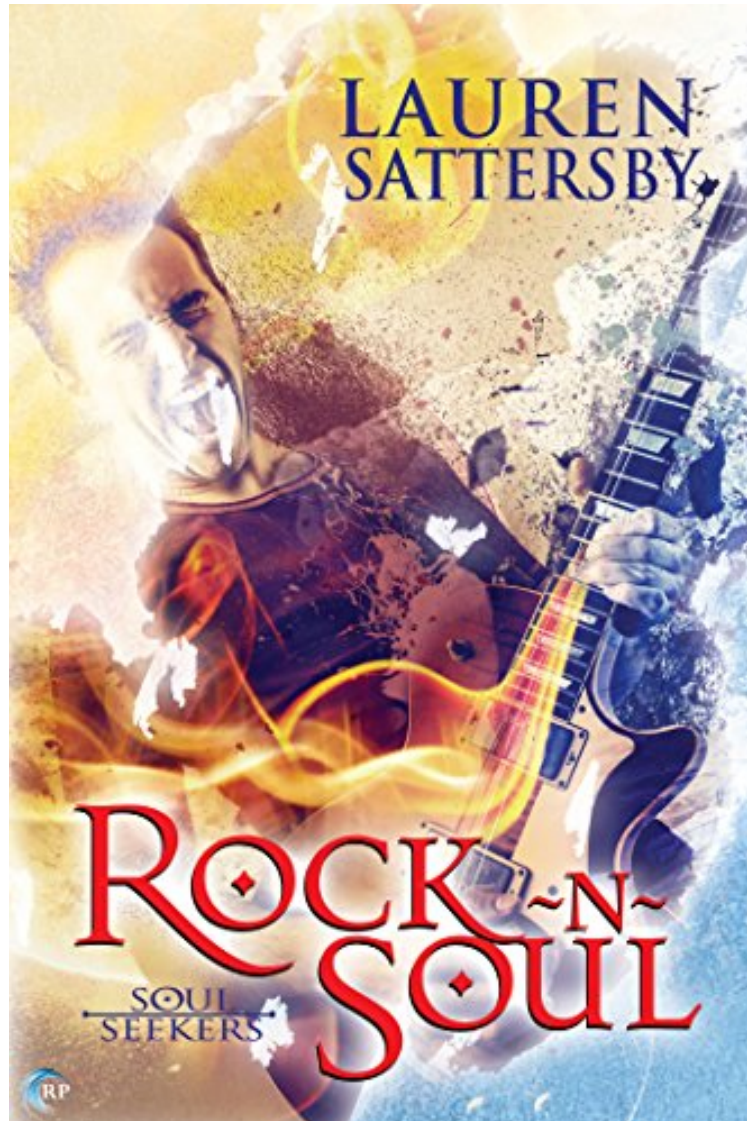

Just like he doesn't expect Chris' ghost to appear when Tyler has to clean up something in the same room about two months after Chris Raiden died. It took me a bit to really get into this story. Mainly because I really didn't understand why Tyler would ever stay with his girlfriend, yes I get that she's apparently a good lay, but seriously, the sex can't be THAT good to endure her constant bitching and complaining. She was just horrible and annoying and I was SO happy when she was out of the picture. The reason why I kept going was Tyler. Mostly his snarky comments. I loved him from the first minute.
