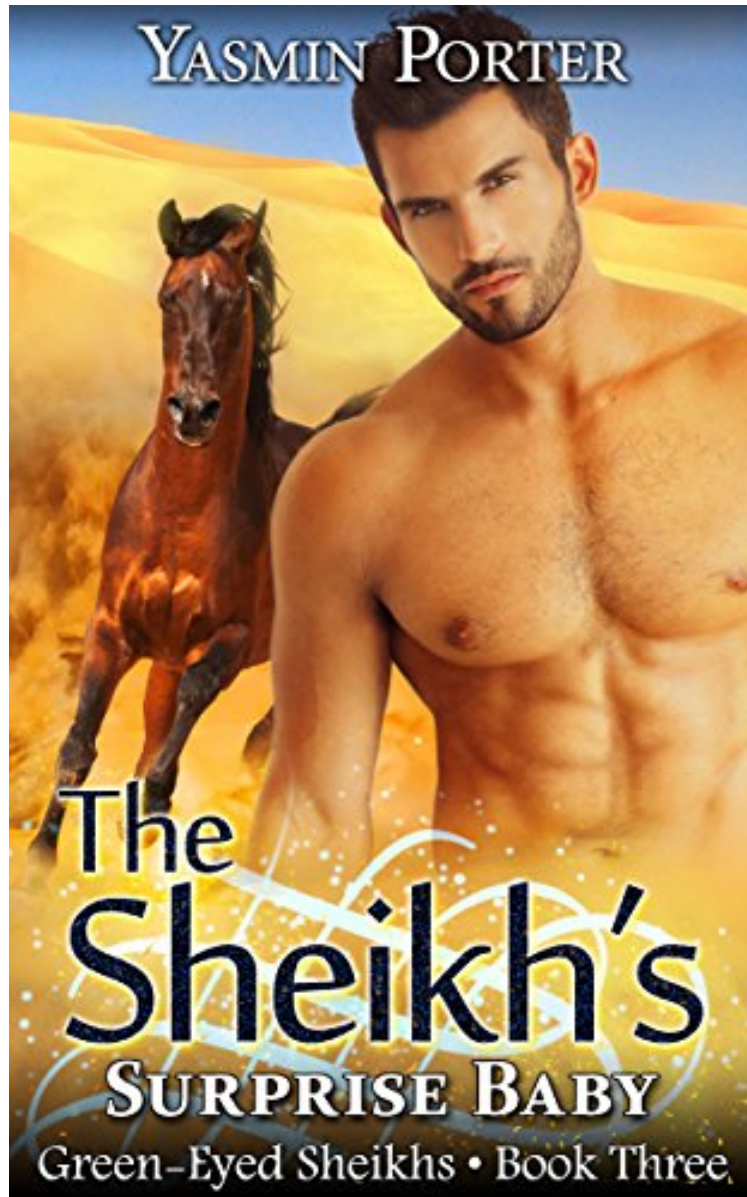

Sie reden kaum miteinander und die Frau spinnt sich in ihren Gedanken etwas zusammen. Was der Scheich denkt, das erfhrt der Leser zu keiner Zeit. Woher also ihre Liebe kam, kann ich mir nur durch die krperliche Anziehung erklren, denn viele Gemeinsamkeiten hatten sie nicht in der kurzen Zeit (1 Woche). Zur Spannungssteigerung wurde noch eine schnelle Entfhrung miteingebaut, die sich genauso schnell wieder auflst.
