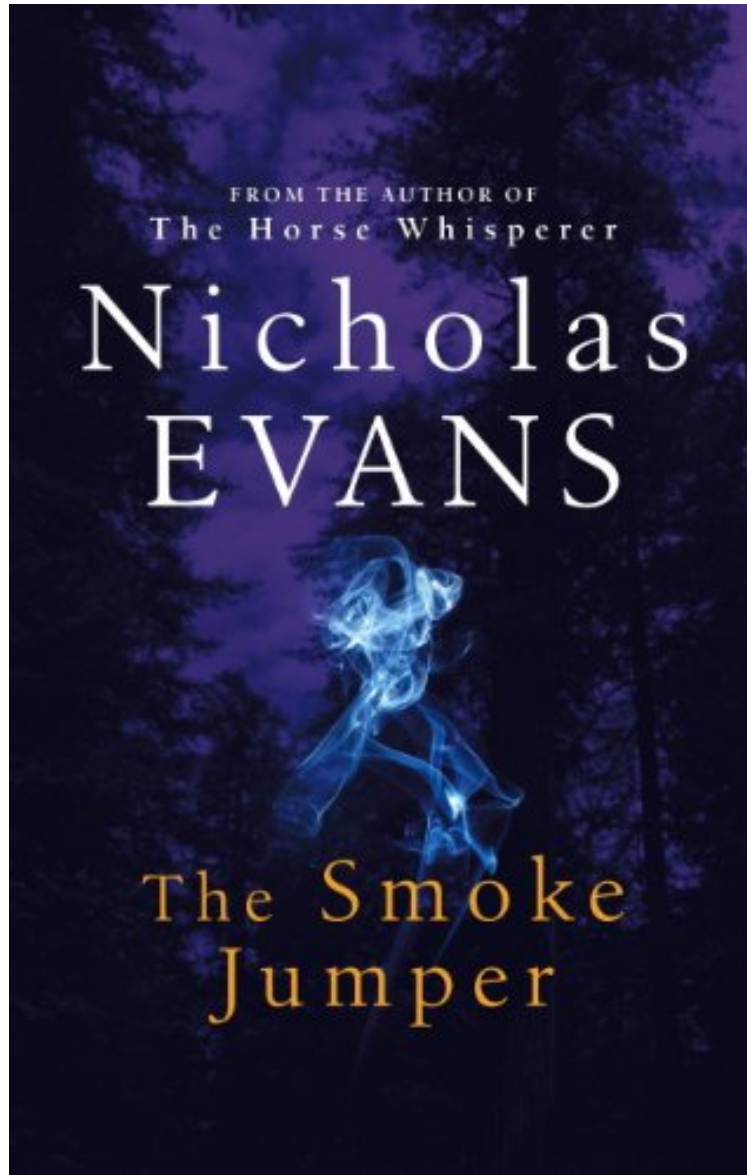

whether it's joy, fear, sadness or even hate. I consider "The Horse Whisperer" to be a modern classic. It is very well written, the characters are believable and it is simply a very good read. Yet, "The Loop" is even better. Set in the most beautiful landscape it tells of all-too human tragedies. Evans successfully combines his skills as a screenwriter and renowned author to create a roller-coaster ride of emotions. Add a fluent read and you have a masterpiece at hand. These two unbelievably fantastic predecessors in mind, "The Smoke Jumper" seems a little inferior. It isn't the writing, for Evans hasn't changed even a bit of his very own style - and that's what's making "The Smoke Jumper" a great piece of literature after all. It isn't the character development either, for the characters are very believable and well worked out. I've just had my problems with the way the story goes. At first I was surprised at what the characters had to endure. Then the story became too predictable and all the drama seemed to run out of Evans' hands, just when the whole plot unawardedly ended in some too extreme and therefore not very believable finale. Nonetheless, "The Smoke Jumper" still is 100% Evans and it's definitely an experience I wouldn't have wanted to miss. The audio version of "The Smoke Jumper" is one of the finest I've ever heard. Luke Perry does a terrific job, his voice unexpectedly fits for every single character of Evans' novel and delivers an additional depth of emotion.
