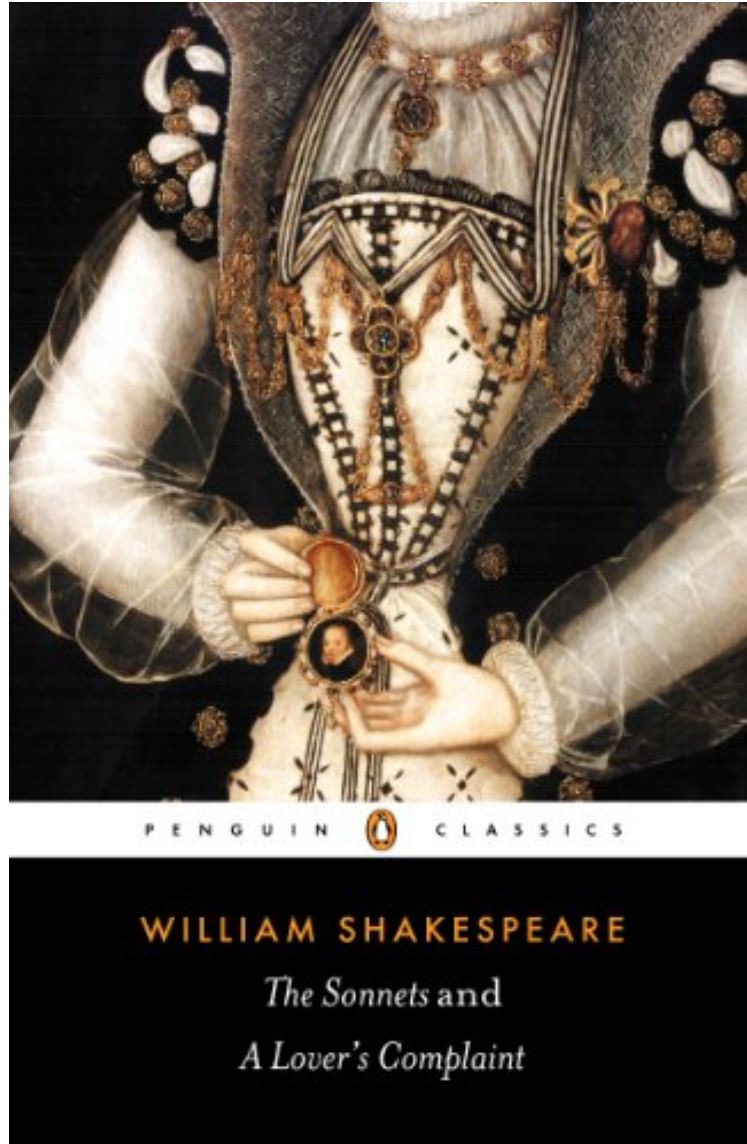

Das Rätsel um die Widmung an den "only begetter, W.H." hat einen Teil der Shakespeare-Forschung veranlasst gesehen, ihm eine homoerotische Beziehung zu William Herbert, dem Earl of Southampton nachzusagen. Dies würde die Sonette 1-126, die allesamt an einen Freund gerichtet sind, in einem anderen Licht erscheinen lassen. Sonette 127-152 sind an eine mysteriöse "dark lady" gerichtet und 153, 154 rekurren auf das Bild des schlafenden Amor. Der Sonettzyklus birgt noch viele Geheimnisse in sich und die Edition von Stanley Wells lädt dazu ein, diese zu ergründen. Eine ähnliche Qualität wird nur noch durch die Ausgabe von John Kerrigan, bei Penguin erschienen, erreicht.
