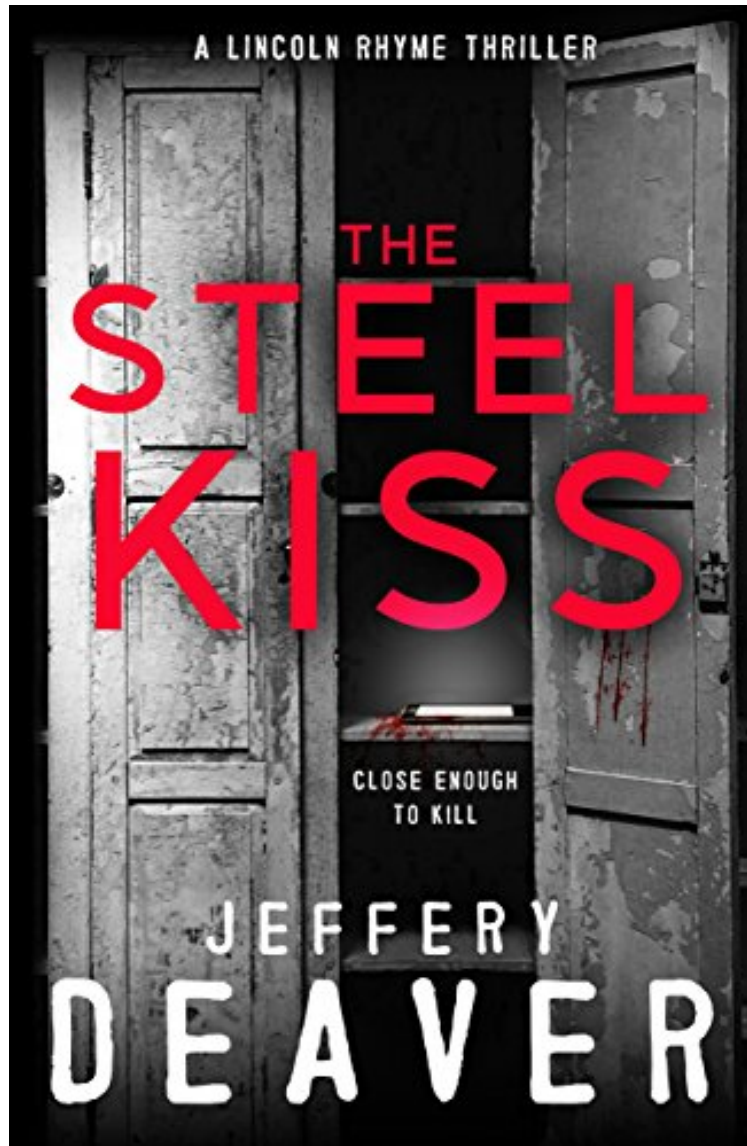

Micha ... way too many plots to resolve them all logically at the very end. But they are partially so intricated that there is simply too much meat cooking on the burners. And some of it got highly over-cooked for my taste. Bloody details with Amelia as a testimony at the beginning, a Lincoln Rhyme admired by his students, that's OK. But then follow technically superior madmen, police officers going maverick, another wheelchair to prop into the action and Lincoln Rhyme's yet crowded house and...and...and... Too much of everything prepped into a book that really could not fascinate me. Once I bought a thriller with Lincoln Amelia plus their friends and helpers right after it was released. But since the last books weren't up to my - maybe too high? - expectations, now I wait 'til the initially pretty high price goes noticeably down or it comes with Kindle Unlimited. Sorry, but this was in MY eyes a mediocre and much too long crime novel with a lot of investigation going around and around. Mittelmiger Thriller mit hohem Konstruiertheitsgrad Von KGBeast Nachdem der Fall Baxter aus Lincoln Rhymes sich eher unbefriedigend aufgelöst hat, hat der Forensiker seine Zusammenarbeit mit dem NYPD aufgekündigt. Die darüber gar nicht glückliche Amelia Sachs schiebt ihm nachdem sie dabei gewesen ist, wie eine Rolltreppe einen Mann gettet hat den damit zusammenhängenden Schadensersatzfall zu, während sie selbst einen neuen Serienkiller durch die Stadt jagt, der die Wunder der modernsten Technik gegen sein Opfer einsetzt - aber durchaus auch mal handgemein wird. Außerdem taucht ihr Exkollege und -liebhaber Nick Carelli mit einem sehr überraschendem Anliegen bei ihr auf. Lincoln selbst, der seit Neuestem auch unterrichtet, sieht sich plötzlich mit einer Praktikantin ausgestattet, die ebenfalls in einem Rollstuhl sitzt. Dies bringt ganz neue Dynamiken in seine Arbeit. Währenddessen begibt sich Ron Pulaski auf eine nicht sanktionierte Undercover-Mission. Hört sich alles ziemlich dicht an und ist es auch in vielerlei Hinsicht. Trotzdem konnte mich die Geschichte nicht wirklich fesseln, da es oft so wirkt, als ob sich die Ermittler bewusst selbst im Wege stehen. Und insbesondere der Pulaski-Erzählstrang wirkt untermotiviert und absolut berflüssig. Und gegen Ende gibt es in jedem einzelnen Handlungsstrang mindestens eine überraschende Enthüllung, die beinahe alle Mitdenkbemühungen der Leserschaft ad absurdum führen - was zwar in dieser Massierung die Wendigkeit des Autors vorführt, den mitdenkenden Leser aber nachgerade dumm dastehen lässt. So entsteht ein mittelprechtiger, etwas langatmiger Roman, den ich zumindest im Endeffekt lieber nicht gelesen hätte.
