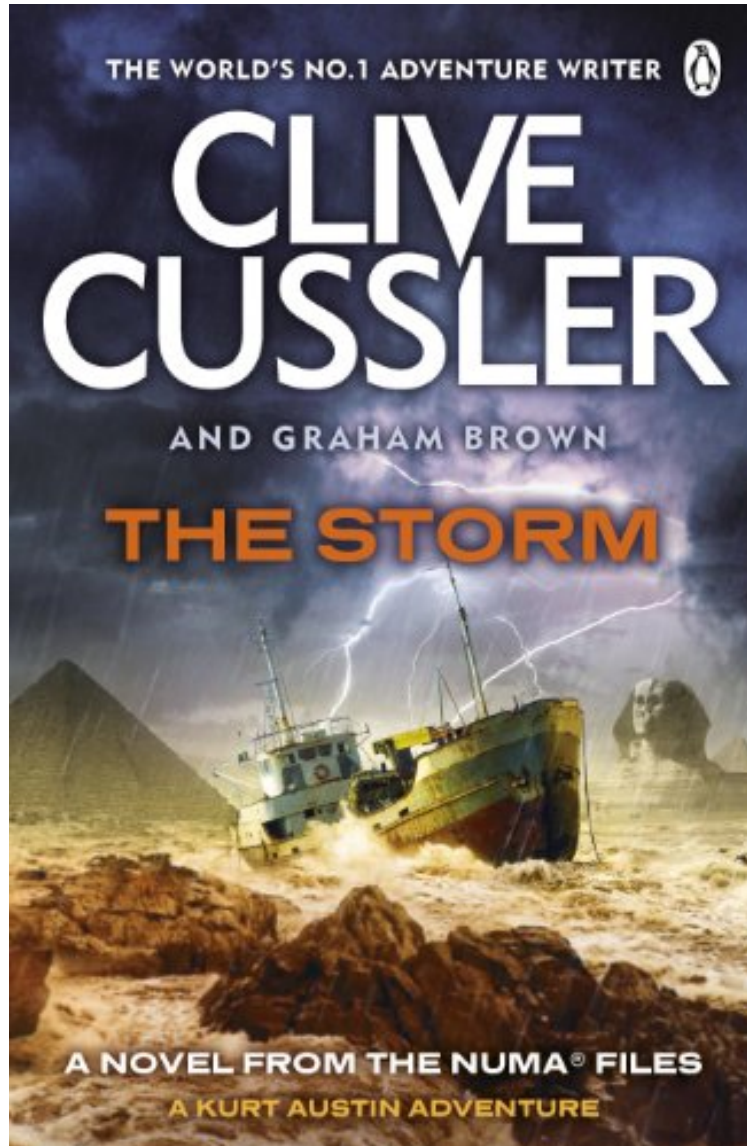

They remind me of the early Dirk Pitt books in their swagger and derring do. The Storm is a timely tale that explores how important the oceans are as a global resource and how they might be used to accomplish more (for harm or for good) in the future. You'll find yourself with plenty of "what if" thoughts as you read the story. The technologies described in the book are also intriguing, independent of the plot. There's nothing like fiction that causes you to think differently about the possibilities in fact. I very much liked the action in The Storm. The ratio of doing to talking is about right in this story. My only complaint about the book is that Graham Brown doesn't do enough to flesh out his characters. For all the differences you perceive in some of them, they might as well be simply called Character 1, Character 2, Character 3, and so forth. If you are about to head off on vacation . . . or a long plane flight, take The Storm with you!
