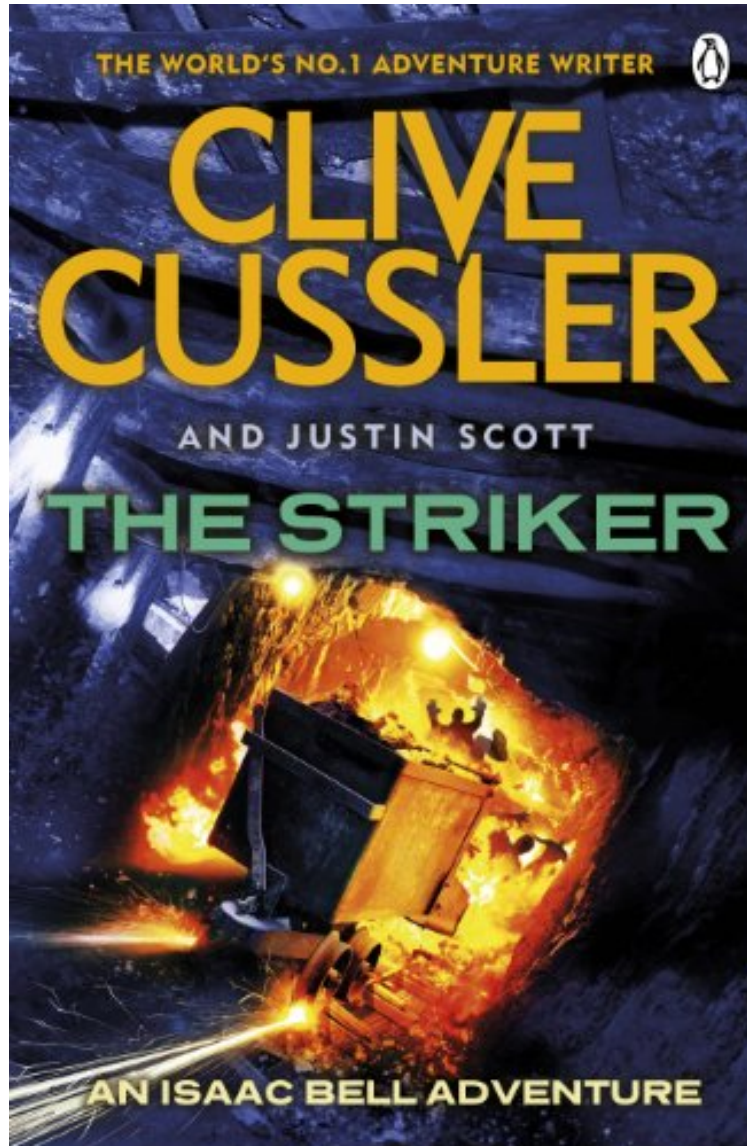

The Striker presents several new dimensions to these elements, ones that I think you'll find intriguing.If you have been reading the series, realize that this novel moves back in time to when Isaac Bell was first earning his credibility as a detective. As such, he makes mistakes ... which add to the story for the most part.I graded the novel down slightly for describing sequences that I could not follow in places. I just made up something in my head, but I'm sure I got it wrong.The overall plot was quite intriguing, and it had more plausibility than some of the other Isaac Bell novels.Unlike other series, I'm not sure it's a good idea to start with this story even though it precedes others in time in the series.
