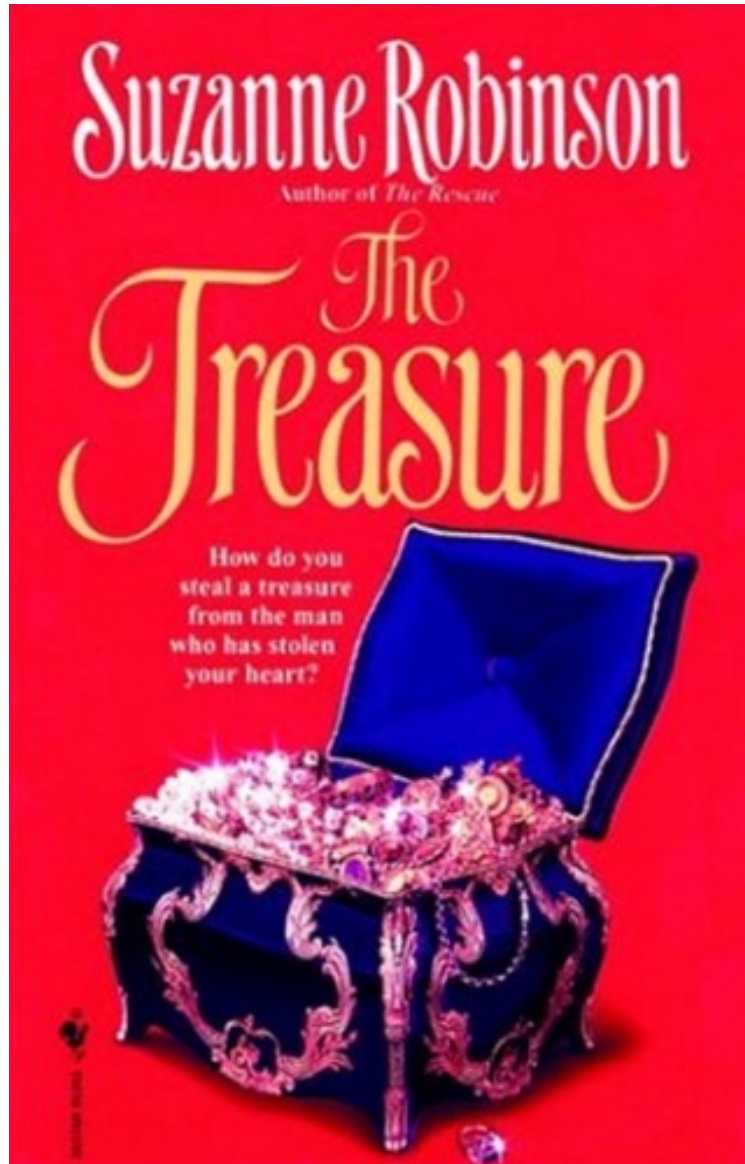

Now she has to go back to the North's (with the name Emily de Winters) and spend enough time there to find the treasure. Valin North is the heir to the family title. As such he must find a wife. No one among the eligibles thrust toward him meets his expectations. That's one of the reasons he walks about with a perpetual frown on his face. Emily de Winters is different. Not only is she irreverent and not seeking to marry him, but she's a sea of contradictions. He has her investigated, finds out she's not who she says she is and forces her to agree to pose as his fiancée until a suitable match is made. Set in 19th century England, Suzanne Robison's latest novel *The Treasure* delivers a charming heroine and troubled hero. Although the interweaving of historical fact is there (a Suzanne Robison trademark), the plot offers nothing new; the conflict between hero and heroine seems forced.
