Von Lili "The trouble with flying" hat mir mal mal wieder sehr beschwingte Lesestunden gewährt: die Geschichte ist wattewolkenfluffig und insgesamt verbirgt sich in diesem eBook eine sehr gelungene NA-Romance! Ich kenne das wohl zuvor spielende "Forgiven" nicht; "The trouble with flying" lie sich nun, wie in der Kurzbeschreibung auch so gesagt, als in sich geschlossener, eigenständiger Roman lesen. Der "mild spoiler", vor dem die Kurzbeschreibung wiederum "warnt", meint vermutlich in erster Linie die nach Romanende angehängte Leseprobe des nachfolgenden Bandes "The trouble with flirting". In zweiter Linie wird zwar am Rande innerhalb von "The trouble with flying" durchaus auch schon jene Geschichte erwähnt, die im Nachfolger fokussiert wird, aber dies geschieht sehr beiläufig und absolut nicht offensiv (auch wenn ich durchaus ein wenig neugierig geworden bin, was Sarahs beste Freundin wohl so von ihrem Liebesleben zu erzählen hat). Mild ist hier auch die Sprache und das gesamte Geschehen: Bse geflucht wird nicht und das Unanständigste, was passiert, sind ein paar wenige Kisse, die oftmals auch in der Öffentlichkeit stattfinden. Sarah wird hier zwar durchaus als gläubig geschildert, es finden auch einige Diskussionen bzw. Überlegungen bzgl. einer Gottes-Existenz statt, aber auch diese laufen eher rational und nachdenklich ab. Ich würde zwar nicht abstreiten, dass es sich hier um ein christliches Buch handeln könnte, würde "The trouble with flying" aber auch nicht zwangsläufig auf diese Schiene schieben: Es handelt sich hier einfach um einen Roman, in dem ab und an darüber nachgedacht wird, ob es Schicksal gibt und ob dieses komplett vorherbestimmt oder doch veränderlich ist. Insgesamt geht es hier auch vor allem darum, als (junger) Erwachsener überhaupt erst einmal zu sich selbst zu finden. Sarah is smitten by Aiden but soon they have to say goodbye to each other at the airport. Will they see each other again? I had some troubles in the beginning to get into the story and enjoyed the second half of the book a bit more than the first half of it but I love the ending, it's really cute. I love how the book title got a second meaning. I thought it's just about the flight from England to Africa, but it's so much more than that. It's about to trust in yourself and taking chances.
