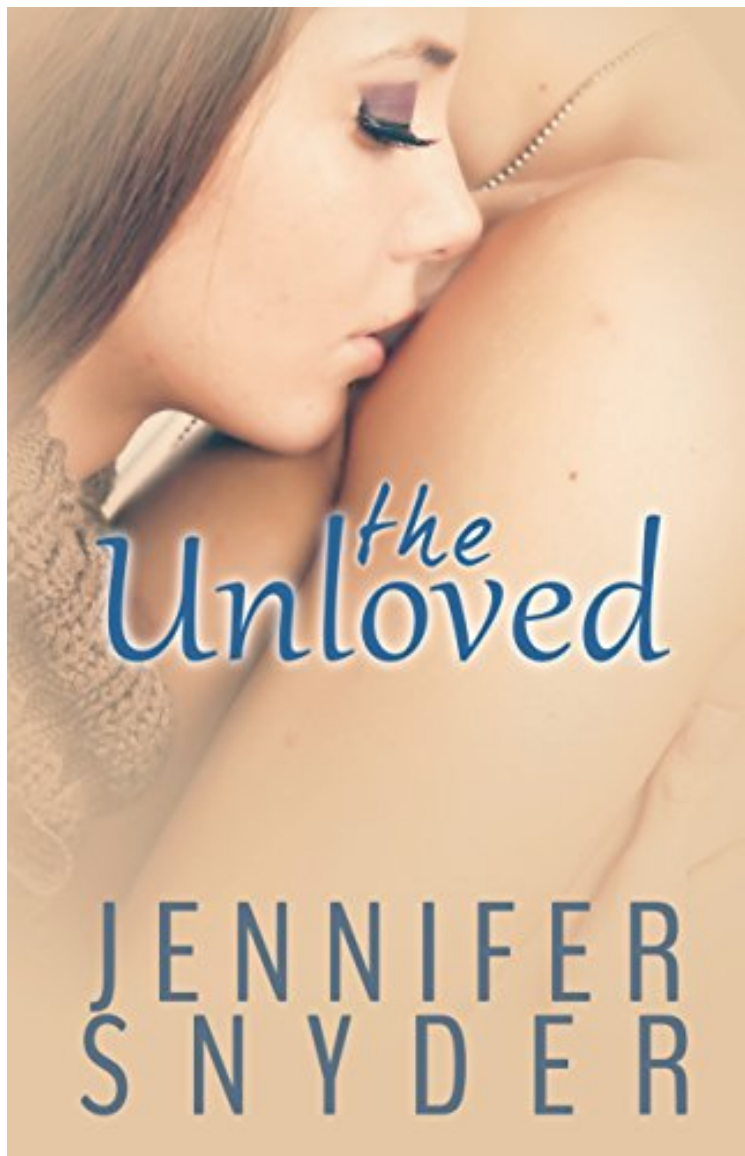

best friend, suffering like him of a horrible home, her mother being a hooker and a drug addict. When he comes back he is stronger and wants to fight for Jules, for his mother and for himself. He has never forgotten her, but witnesses as she is nearly broken. The writing is strange. The chapters are alternatively written from Jules or from Nick's point of view. And maybe according to the age of the main characters the style is very simple, maybe too much so. I also had a problem with switching from one character to the other, not really having the time identify or really understand the feelings from one or the other. And there are some flaws in editing. The characters are interesting mainly because of their difficult lives and their way to cope with it. But still I missed some of their feelings or the feeling of suffering, despair, hope and happiness. My main problem is that this book reminds me of a mixture of three other books: (Attention eventual SPOILER) Heart on a Chain, because of him coming back to be with her, to help her, because of the terrible mother the female main character has, also because of the death (I don't want to say whose) and because of some other things as well too long to enumerate here. The Boy Who Sneaks in my Bedroom Window because of the neighborhood factor, the abusive man in her life, the youth of the characters and the seriousness of their relation. And Almost because of the rape factor.... Well yes a rape is taking place and you should be aware of that to be able to choose if you want to read this book. And that I liked all three other better, I got more emotion from them was often close to crying for the characters. Here however I was reading not feeling... I would probably have liked this book more if I hadn't read the other three first. You have to choose how intense you want such a difficult story about abused teenagers to be.
